Lighthouse Point team members have been busy both on the project site and off. Most will say that the most rewarding part of their jobs is connecting with the surrounding communities. Here's what we've been up to.



By partnering with the South Abaco District Local Government Authority, we were able to equip more than 1,300 students with backpacks stuffed with school supplies for the upcoming year.

- American Bridge Bahamas worked with local government officials to hire a local subcontractor to perform pothole repairs in South Eleuthera.
- Meal distribution to those in need in Deep Creek. By working with local police, we were able to identify those who could use a little assistance and delivered bags of non-perishables to each person.
- Surplus food distributions to residents in Rock Sound.
- Disney and American Bridge Bahamas purchased all the necessary materials to repair the Homecoming Field in Wemyss Bight. A local contractor was able to replace the pavilion roof and outside walls of the concession stands. Ongoing work includes wiring and breaker box replacement.
